Dock2Office uses Kickstarter for revolutionary docking station *The Sphinx transforms every tablet into a desktop workstation*

A crowdfunding campaign that is set to start today on Kickstarter, aims to help the Dutch company Dock2Office finance the production of the Sphinx. The Sphinx is a revolutionary docking station that transforms every tablet into a desktop workstation, enabling the tablet to be used comfortably with a keyboard and mouse.

People can co-finance new projects on Kickstarter by pledging an amount that will help the project get off the ground. The company hopes to raise at least 125,000 dollars. There are a variety of ways to donate, and donors then receive compensation, or the product itself, in return. This might be a discount off the purchase of the Sphinx, for example, which will be sold for 185 dollars on Kickstarter.

The announcement of the Sphinx last week attracted a great deal of attention on tech sites. This is not so surprising considering the Sphinx, developed by the Dutch company Dock2Office, is the first product of its kind to meet a growing need. The Sphinx enables tablet users to work with every business application the way they are used to doing on their desktops or laptops. It changes every tablet into a desktop workstation. This is the ideal solution for anyone who has to work at different locations, yet doesn't want to have to take several devices along with them to do so.

The various technological developments available today make it easier than ever to work on location. Many business users have discovered the convenience of using tablets in their work; it's no surprise, therefore, that research shows that 94% of companies listed in the Forbes 500 use tablets.

The Sphinx was developed to ensure that all the business possibilities for tablets could be utilized. It is the world's first intelligent docking station that uses patent pending Dock2Office technology. When used in combination with a mouse and desktop keyboard, this technology makes it possible to use a tablet for every business application in a virtual desktop environment.

Dock2Office expects the Sphinx to be used at a variety of off-site locations such as hotels, airports, schools and flexible workplaces. This enables you to get down to business, always and everywhere, and combines the best of both worlds: the portability, flexibility and convenience of a tablet with the productivity and comfort of working on a desktop computer. The Sphinx also promotes good ergonomic posture while working, preventing problems such as "tablet neck syndrome" and "the Gorilla arm".
